Course fees are \$135.00/person (Adult or Youth) Youth scholarships, partial and full, are available when needed. Adult CPR/AED Certification from a BSA “recognized training organization,” including a skills check supervised by an instructor is a HARD prerequisite. Qualified high school health elective programs are acceptable for YOUTH Participants only. Adults should provide a copy of their current certification from an approved provider at check-in. (We recommend ARC)

There is no added charge for participants arriving Friday night. We encourage youth participants to take part in the Friday night Crew-911 Event.

The minimum age for youth participants is fourteen, (or completed eighth grade and a registered Sea Scout or Venturer, or the GSUSA equivalent.) Comparable aged Trail Life and American Heritage Girls’ youth members and adult leaders are welcome.
